## 18-Day China Highlight & Yangtze River (Upstream) Odyssey (A)

### Day 1 (Wed.) Honolulu – Beijing

We start our vacation by boarding an international flight bound for Beijing, the capital of China and an ancient city of great splendor. Meals and snacks will be served on the plane.

### Day 2 (Thu.) Beijing

Arrive at Beijing Capital Int'l Airport. A Grande Holiday representative will greet and escort us to our hotel.

### Day 3 (Fri.) Beijing (AB, L, D)

In the morning, we'll walk around *Tiananmen Square*, probably the largest and most magnificent public square in the world. Explore *The Forbidden City*, the largest and best-preserved imperial palace whose vast and exotic grandeur was brilliantly captured in the movie *The Last Emperor*. Tour the *Summer Palace*, former summer retreat for the imperial family during the late Qing Dynasty and now China's largest and most well-preserved royal garden. Afterwards, enjoy a visit to the *fresh-water pearl shop*. In the evening, take pleasure in traditional *Chinese Martial Arts with the "Legend of Kung Fu" Show*.

### Day 4 (Sat.) Beijing (AB, L, SD)

Begin today's full tour with a visit to a *jade workshop*, where we will learn about Chinese jade culture. Drive through the peaceful valley where Ming emperors had chosen as their burial ground, and descend for a walk along the *Sacred Way*, where the Avenue of the Animals can be seen lined with massive stone statues. In the afternoon, ascend by *cable car*, to the fabled *Badaling Great Wall*, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and a massive defensive structure built to keep off intrusion. Tonight's dinner features China's famous *Peking Duck*.

### Day 5 (Sun.) Beijing – Xi'an (AB, L, SD)

In the morning, visit the *Temple of Heaven*; widely regarded as the noblest example of religious architectures in all of China, it was the site where emperors came to worship heaven for a bountiful harvest. Proceed for our entry to *Tongrentang*, China's most famous traditional pharmacy, where you could learn the mystifying Chinese theory of Yin & Yang balance. Fly to Xi'an later in the day. Upon arrival, attend a *hot-pot dinner* at a local restaurant.

### Day 6 (Mon.) Xi'an (AB, L, SD)

Go to one of the most exciting archaeological finds of the 20th Century - more than 6,000 of excavated *Terracotta Warriors*. Pay a visit to *Shaanxi Provincial Museum*, which beholds a treasure of 113,000 historic and cultural artifacts unearthed in Shaanxi. Today's exploration also includes a stop at a *lacquer ware factory*. Enjoy a fabulous night of *Dumpling Banquet Dinner* and the *Tang Dynasty Show*.

### Day 7 (Tue.) Xi'an – Shanghai – Suzhou (AB, L, D)

Explore the *Big Wild Goose Pagoda*, a famous Buddhist pagoda in China. Visit the *City Wall* - one of the few ancient city walls still standing in China. In the afternoon, board a short flight to Shanghai. Upon arrival, we'll drive straight to Suzhou, which is known as 'Venice of the East' with its network of canal streets that are criss-crossed by 300 bridges.

### Day 8 (Wed.) Suzhou – Shanghai (AB, L, D)

Take a boat ride along the *Grand Canal*; second only to the Great Wall as a Chinese engineering feat, it was constructed 2,400 years ago. Take in graceful bridges that cross over the water, and tile-roofed whitewashed houses that sit close to shore. Follow on with a visit to the *Garden for Lingering In*. As Suzhou is famous for its delicate and smooth silk and embroidery, we've arranged for a visit to a silk factory as well. Drive back to Shanghai. Attend the most famous *Chinese Acrobatic Show* in the evening.

- Day 9 (Thu) Shanghai (AB, L, SD)**  
Explore the *Pudong New Development Area* and visit the *Oriental Pearl TV Tower*, where you could get a bird's eye view of the bustling city. Travel along the famous *Bund*, a five-block long riverfront promenade containing many of Shanghai's banks and trading houses. We'll also make a stop at a nearby *Carpet Factory*. Afterwards, do some leisure shopping at the *City God Temple Open Market*. Enjoy a *Brazilian B.B.Q. dinner*.
- Day 10 (Fri.) Shanghai – Yichang – Yangtze River (AB, L, SD)**  
Fly to Wuhan where we will drive to Yichang, known as "Gateway to the Three Gorges" for a long time. In the evening, we will start our *Yangtze River Adventure* with *5-Star Victoria Cruises (Victoria Anna)*.
- Day 11 (Sat.) Yangtze River (AB, L, D)**  
In the morning, we will visit the *Three Gorges Dam site*, the biggest dam in the world and a large water conservation project for flood control, generation, cultivation and flood discharge. We will sail through the *Three Gorges ship locks* and *Xiling Gorge*, the longest gorge within the three gorges known for its swift currents and dangerous shoal.
- Day 12 (Sun.) Yangtze River (AB, L, D)**  
Today, we will take an excursion in a small boat exploring the *Shennong Stream* or *Daning River Small Gorges*. In the afternoon, the ship will enter *Wu Gorge*, which is famous for its meandering waterways. Additionally, the fog bestows a distinct beauty. Then the ship enters *Qutang Gorge*, the shortest, narrowest but most striking section of the three gorges, with sky-soaring majestic mountains on both its sides.
- Day 13 (Mon.) Yangtze River (AB, L, D)**  
Today, we will take a shore excursion to *Fengdu* or *Shibaozhai*. Fengdu is an ancient city with a long history, located on the north bank of the Yangtze River, also known as the "Abode of Ghosts."
- Day 14 (Tue.) Yangtze River – Chongqing – Shenzhen (AB, L)**  
The Yangtze River Adventure concludes in the city of Chongqing. It presents a unique magnificent picture with miles of roads and streets winding up and down the hills and along the riverbanks. Then fly to Shenzhen, a famous shopping heaven. The rest of today affords you the opportunity to get acquainted with Shenzhen on your own.
- Day 15 (Wed.) Shenzhen (AB, D)**  
Free at leisure in the morning. In the afternoon, visit the *China Cultural Village* and *Splendid China*. After dinner, watch the night show "*Dances & Music between the Dragon and the Phoenix*"
- Day 16 (Thu.) Shenzhen – Hong Kong (AB)**  
Take the coach to Hong Kong, the Harbor of Fragrance. After check-in at your hotel, explore the charm and dynamic beauty of Hong Kong at your leisure.
- Day 17 (Fri.) Hong Kong**  
Free at leisure.
- Day 18 (Sat.) Hong Kong – Honolulu**  
After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight home, taking with you lasting memories of a wonderful trip.
