### Day 1: Nagoya - Takayama

Place of Stay: Takayama

<b>11:20 a.m.</b>	Assemble at Nagoya Marriott Associa Hotel (2nd floor lobby). walking Nagoya Station train <Limited Express Hida/150 min> Takayama Station walking Yatai Kaikan Hall (30 min) walking Kusakabe Folk Museum (20 min) walking Kami Sannomachi Street (30 min) walking
<b>5:30-6:30 p.m.</b>	Stay at Hida Hotel Plaza.

### Day 2: Takayama - Shirakawago - Kanazawa

Place of Stay: Kanazawa

<b>8:30 a.m.</b>	Hotel walking Takayama Morning Market (30 min) walking Takayama Station motorcoach <local bus> ★ Shirakawa-go/Gassho-zukuri Folklore Park /Wada Family Residence (180 min) motorcoach <local bus / 75 min> Kanazawa Station walking
<b>3:00-3:30 p.m.</b>	Stay at Hotel Nikko Kanazawa.

### Day 3: Kanazawa - Nagoya

## Remarks

- Depending upon traffic, weather, or operation conditions, a motorcoach may be used to transfer from Nagoya Station to Takayama Station.
- JTB staff will not meet participants at Nagoya Station on Day 3.
- This tour is available for overseas visitors to Japan only. Residents of Japan may not participate in this tour.
- We recommend wearing clothes and comfortable shoes. Please bring a coat and warm clothes from the chilly month of October to the snowy month of February.
- When the former Wada family residence and the Gassho-zukuri Folklore Park are closed, or during days of heavy snow in the winter, the tour may visit the Nagase Residence or Myozenji Temple instead.
- The tour will visit Kusakabe Folk Museum and Kamisanno-machi on Day 2 if the museum is closed on Day 1.
- Transfers on Day 2 will be conducted by shared highway bus and transfers on Day 3 will be conducted by local transportation.
- Standard Plan: Superior Room use in Hotel Nikko Kanazawa / Deluxe Plan: Executive room use in Hotel Nikko Kanazawa
